Chapter 1.12 - CORPORATE SEAL¹

1.12.010 Design described.1.12.020 Adoption.1.12.030 Custody and use authorized--Clerk duty.

1.12.010 Design described.

The corporate seal of the city shall be circular in form with an outer circle of rope design and such circle shall be one and three-fourths inches in diameter, and the inner circle shall be one and one-eighth inches in diameter. It shall bear upon the upper portion of space between the two circles the words "City of Arco, in Gothic style type, and upon the lower portion of space between the two circles the words "Arco, Idaho" in Gothic style type. Across the space within the inner circle and exactly in the center of said space shall be the word "Seal" in Roman style type. (Ord. 1975-5 §2, 1975: prior code §1-4-1).

1.12.020 Adoption.

The seal hereinabove described is adopted as the corporate seal of the city of Arco, Butte County, Idaho. (Prior code §1-4-2).

1.12.030 Custody and use authorized--Clerk duty.

The clerk shall be custodian of the corporate seal and shall affix said seal's imprint upon all official documents, records, licenses, warrants and/or checks. (Prior code §1-4-3).
