10.24.010 Driving through processions prohibited when.

It is unlawful for a driver of a vehicle to drive between the vehicles comprising a funeral or other authorized procession while they are in motion and when such vehicles are conspicuously designated. (Prior code §10-2-7(C)).

10.24.02.0 Driving procedures required.

Each driver in a funeral or other procession shall drive as near to the right-hand edge of the roadway as practical and shall follow the vehicle ahead as close as is practical and safe. (Prior code §10-2-7(D)).

10.24.030 Funeral processions–Identification required.

A funeral composed of a procession of vehicles shall be identified as such by the display upon the outside of each vehicle of a pennant or other identifying insignia or by such other method as may be determined and designated by the chief of police. (Prior code §10-2-7(E))

10.24.040 Permit required when.

It is unlawful for any funeral procession or parade containing persons or vehicles to occupy, march or proceed along any street except in accordance with a permit issued by the chief of police and such other regulations as are set forth. (Prior code §10-2-7(F)).
