

## **Chapter 10.32 - RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS <sup>1</sup>**

Sections:

- 10.32.010 Heavy vehicles—Operation prohibited when.
- 10.32.020 No motorized traffic and motorcycle restrictions authorized when.
- 10.32.030 Lug wheels prohibited when.

### **10.32.010 Heavy vehicles—Operation prohibited when.**

When signs are erected by authority of the governing body giving notice thereof, it is unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle with a gross weight in excess of the amounts specified. (Prior code §10-2-14(A)).

### **10.32.020 No motorized traffic and motorcycle restrictions authorized when.**

- A. The chief of police is authorized to determine and designate those heavily traveled streets upon which shall be prohibited the use of the roadway by motor-driven cycles, bicycles, horse drawn vehicles or other no motorized traffic and shall erect appropriate signs giving notice thereof.
- B. When signs are so erected giving notice thereof, it is unlawful for any person to disobey the restrictions stated on such signs. (Prior code §10-2-14(B)).

### **10.32.030 Lug wheels prohibited when.**

It is unlawful for tractors with wheels injurious to pavement to be permitted upon the public thoroughfares unless the operator of such vehicles shall first plank such streets. (Prior code §6-1-30)
