Chapter 10.56 - VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITS

10.56.010 Designated.10.56.020 Applicability.10.56.030 Violation--Penalty.

10.56.010 Designated.

It is unlawful for any person, partnership or corporation, *to* drive or cause to be driven any motor vehicle upon the streets, alleys or roadways of the city, which has a total weight which exceeds three hundred fifty pounds per inch of tire width, or which exceeds fourteen thousand pounds per axle, on the vehicle. Cord. 1978-1 §1, 1978).

10.56.020 Applicability.

This chapter shall not apply to portions of state or federal highways within the limits of the city. (Ord. 1978-1 §2, 1978).

10.56.030 Violation--Penalty.

Violation of this chapter shall be punishable by fine of not more than one hundred dollars or imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. (Ord. 1978-1 §3, 1978).
