

Chapter 18.04 – Intent–Purpose

18.04.010 Intent.

In enacting this ordinance, it is the intent of the City to ensure the health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the persons patronizing, working at, or otherwise coming in contact with the businesses regulated herein, and to fund the expense of inspection, administration, and regulation by charging a license fee.

18.04.020 Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to ensure that any person owning or operating as an itinerant and/or transient business within the City of Arco may be charged and/or convicted of violating this ordinance. A corporation's officers and managerial personnel are considered owners/operators for the purpose of this ordinance and may be charged with its violation.

18.04.030 Interstate Commerce.

Nothing in this ordinance is intended to operate as to interfere with the power of the United States to regulate interstate commerce between the states as such power is defined by the Supreme Court of the United States.

18.04.040 Severability.

If any part of this Title is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, it is hereby declared that the remainder shall not be affected thereby, but that the City would have enacted this Title and each part thereof notwithstanding that any part be declared invalid.
