# **Chapter 2.12 - APPOINTIVE OFFICERS** <sup>1</sup>

### 2.12.010 Mayor appointment authority.

The mayor shall appoint, subject to approval of the council, a clerk, attorney, engineer, police chief, fire chief and treasurer. The mayor may appoint, subject to approval by the council, such other officers as may be deemed necessary for the efficient operation of the business of the municipality. (Prior code §1-11-1)

#### 2.12.020 Terms of office.

All appointments shall be made for a specified term. (Prior code §1-11-2).

## 2.12.030 Removal from office.

Any appointed officer may be removed from office by the same authority and in the same manner as he was originally appointed. (Prior code §1-11-3).

## 2.12.040 Bonds required. <sup>2</sup>

Certain officers shall give bonds in favor of the municipality with two or more sureties, or surety bonds may be furnished in lieu of personal bonds as follows:

- A. Clerk \$25,000.00;
- B. Treasurer \$5,000.00;
- C. Chief of police \$ 1,000.00.
