Chapter 2.36 - CITY ENGINEER ¹

2.36.010 Appointment and term of office.

The mayor may appoint, with the approval of the council, an engineer who shall hold his office for the duration of his appointment or until such time as he may be removed by the mayor with the concurrence of the council. (Prior Code §1-18-1).

2.36.020 Qualifications required.

Any person appointed as engineer shall be a competent engineer and surveyor and shall be duly licensed as such by the state of Idaho. (Prior code §1-18-3).

2.36.030 Supervision and approval required when.

The engineer shall approve all public works and all plans and specifications for public works, construction for which the expenditure will be two thousand dollars or more, except that the engineer's direct supervision and approval must be obtained on all work where the public health or safety is involved. (Prior code §1-18-2).
