

Arco City Council
Regular Meeting Minutes
May 27, 2025

In attendance: Mayor Parsons, Council members Tessmer, McCurdy, Reese and Darland. City Clerk Jensen, Deputy Clerk Smith, Maintenance Supervisor Tony Chisham, PZ Chair Rebecca Lange and Airport Manager John Muffett. At 7:00 pm Mayor Parsons called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes from the May 12th meeting were read and approved. Public comments given by Rosanne Smith about the need for a public hearing regarding the master fee schedule and the business license, both matters were tabled with no resolutions being passed.

Airport Runway Rehab Project - Ardurra/Jared Norton

Project is ready for the bidding process; bid will be published in The Advertiser. Norton brought the contract for The City to sign; Butte County had signed their agreement for their portion of the project at their meeting earlier in the day. Council voted on signing The City's contract, approved unanimously.

LSLR Project – Forsgren/Camille Miller

Miller presented the Council with an agreement for their services for the LSLR project, this includes preparing the bid package, bid servicing, overseeing inspections, documentation and the backfilling process in the resident's yard. Council approved Mayor Parsons signing of the agreement.

Sewer Project - Forsgren/Altura/Rick Miller

Funding avenues have become hard to find; the project is not feasible without raising utility rates substantially. With the wastewater study being completed, the project is on hold in hopes additional funding will be available in the future.

Bills

Bills were reviewed and approved for payment in the amount of \$58,064.91

Roundtable

Mayor Parsons: County dump station was plugged and therefore shutdown.

Council President Tessmer: Expressed the Council's intention to be transparent and table matters until further public comment and discussions can be had. Encouraged the public to attend City meetings.

Councilman McCurdy: Inquired as to how long individuals are allowed to live in RV's parked in a yard. Council President suggested contacting the Code Enforcer.

Councilwoman Reese: Spoke about the upcoming LRMC Softball Tournament, neighbors around the ball field have been contacted. Clerk Jensen suggested that something also be published in the paper.

Councilwoman Darland: Chip seal project will be starting soon, completing a mile of roads with Arco before Atomic Days.

Clerk Jensen: Raised the issue of the health of the trees along the hill, the sprinkler system has been ruined and in is need of repair. Maintenance Supervisor Chisham said the efforts will be made to repair it. Former Mayor Langseth contacted her and commented that he thought the City was doing a great job.

Rebecca Lange: Spoke about the upcoming conditional use permit hearing for Kim Sanders. Notifications have been sent out to the neighbors in the impact area and a notification has been published in the paper. Discussion was also held about buildings in disrepair throughout the City; it was suggested that the City Code Enforcer be notified so he can contact property owners.
