

Chapter 5.14 - WINE¹

5.14.010 License–Required–Fee.

5.14.020 Beer license required–Times of sale.

5.14.010 License–Required–Fee.

It is unlawful for any person or retail establishment to sell wine not to be consumed on the premises within the city without first having procured a license for the retail sale of wine from the city. The annual fee for this license shall be two hundred dollars. (Ord. 1982-3 §1, 1982).

5.14.020 Beer license required–Times of sale.

As a prerequisite to the grant of a license for the retail sale of wine not to be consumed on the premises by the city, the license applicant shall first be found to be licensed for the retail sale of beer not to be consumed on the premises and the licensee shall be in compliance with all city and county ordinances and state laws regulating the retail sale of beer not to be consumed on the premises. As to hours and days of sale, retailers of wine not to be consumed on the premises in the city shall be in compliance with state law. (Ord. 1982-3 §2, 1982)
