5.28.010 Declared nuisance when.

The practice of going into and upon private residences and property for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares or merchandise or of selling or otherwise disposing of goods, wares or merchandise, unless done at the invitation or request of the owner or occupant, is declared to be a nuisance. (Prior code §5-6-1).

5.28.020 Exceptions to applicability.

The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to the sale or soliciting of orders for sale or disposal of farm and garden produce when so offered by the actual grower or producer thereof. (Prior code §5-6-2).
