Chapter 5.30 - ITINERANT MERCHANTS

5.30.010 License required.

It shall be unlawful to do business in the city as an itinerant merchant without first having secured a license therefore as provided in this chapter. For the purpose of this chapter, any merchant engaging or intending to engage in business as a merchant in the city for a period of time, not exceeding ninety days, shall be considered as an itinerant merchant, provided that a peddler shall not be considered as itinerant merchant. (Ord.1975-6 \$1~1975).

5.30.020 Applications.

Every application for such a license shall set forth the commodities to be sold, and the place intended to be occupied or used for the business. (Ord. 1975-6 §2~ 1975).

5.30.030 Fees.

The fees for such licenses shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per day or fifty dollars (\$50.00) for one month. (Ord. 1975-6 §3, 1975).
