

## **Chapter 5.32 - BILLIARD AND POOL HALLS, CARD ROOMS**

### **5.32.010 License--Required--Application contents.**

It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate, maintain or conduct a billiard or pool table, coin-operated amusement device, vending machine or any other coin- operated machine, or any amusement device operated for a fee, open to the public, without having first obtained a license therefore as herein required. All applications for such licenses shall state thereon the intended location of the place of business and the number of tables or machines to be used therein. (Ord. 1975-5 §15(part), 1975: prior code §5-8-1).

### **5.32.020 License--Fee--Expiration date-Nontransferable.**

Before a license shall be issued to any person to operate any device enumerated in Section 5.32.010, said person shall pay to the clerk a license fee of twenty dollars per table or machine, which said license shall expire on the last day of each year. The license issued under this chapter shall be nontransferable. (Ord. 1975-5 §15 (part) , 1975: prior code §5-8-2).

### **5.32.030 Minors prohibited where--Exceptions.**

It is unlawful for any licensee under Section 5.32.010 to allow any child under the age of fourteen years to play or operate any pool table or other amusement device for pay, and it shall further be unlawful for any such owner to allow any child under the age of fourteen years to frequent, loiter, go or remain in any room where such pool table, billiard table or other coin-operated amusement device shall be in use; provided, that this prohibition relating to frequenting, loitering, going or remaining in any room shall not apply to state-licensed eating establishments.
